



Rebecca's Rooms is a non-profit organization that was created in 2012 by Reid Carter in memory of his daughter, Rebecca, who passed away in December 2010. Rebecca was born with Trisomy 13, a chromosomal abnormality, which causes multiple disabilities and medical problems.

We are a Nonprofit organization giving children and adults with disabilities a newly modified and redecorated room that will be customized to their personality and needs because a child's room should be fun, stimulating and even relaxing when needed. We will also work with the family to address other needs that child or family may have.

Projects are completed over a weekend. The recipient family is treated to a weekend get-away while renovations are being made. After just one year of serving our community, we completed eight projects.

Each room project receives around \$1500.00 in renovations. Plans are made in advance but at times there are additional issues that arise during the project resulting in higher than projected costs. This is why every donation, no matter how small, is greatly appreciated.

In September 2014 we started a new campaign called Rebecca's RoomMates. RoomMates donate \$1500.00 toward the cost of the room renovation. It is an opportunity for businesses or individuals to get involved to change a child's life. RoomMates will receive a plaque with a picture of the room recipient and all the volunteers, will receive a T-Shirt designed for that child's room, receive Media coverage, will be recognized on our website and the Name of the Business or persons will go on our Rebecca's Rooms trailer. RoomMates are also invited and encouraged to attend the reveal to meet the family and team of volunteers.
